

Using an Amazon tablet?

We have discovered that because Amazon and Google are rival companies, the google classroom app is not in the amazon app store. It is possible to install the app, but you would have to bypass some of the system security settings and we would not recommend this.

What we can suggest instead, is that you use the 'Silk Browser' which is the Amazon version of Google Chrome for accessing the web. This has a swirly circular icon which looks a bit like a marble.

I would suggest opening the Silk Browser app, then going to <https://classroom.google.com>

It should take you to the classroom page, but it might redirect you first, but simply click on the 'Go to Classroom' button.

Your child should be able to help you log them in at this stage, having had lessons on it in school. If they or you are unsure, google have a tutorial here:

If your child has their own tablet, you save their login details to the browser if you would to.
